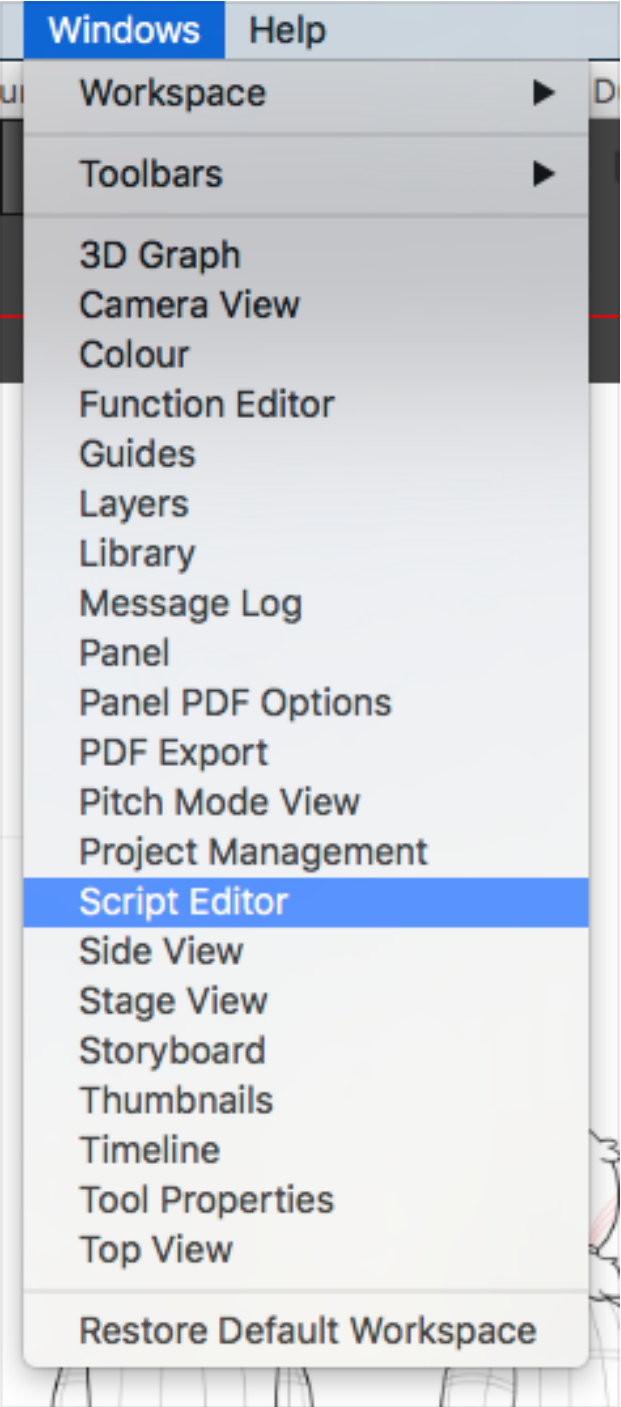


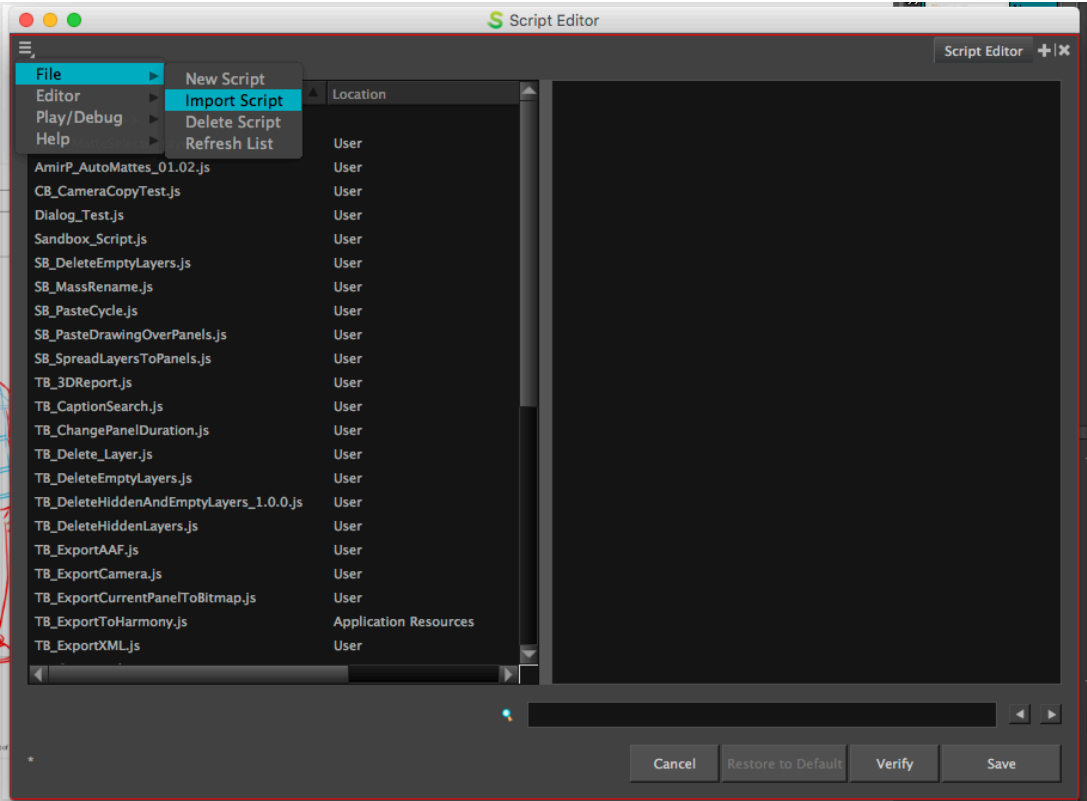
HOW TO INSTALL STORYBOARD PRO SCRIPTS

Drag the scripts you'd like to add to your desktop. Since we are not allowed access to our scripts folder, the scripts must be imported manually through Script Editor. The script editor can be found under the Windows tab.

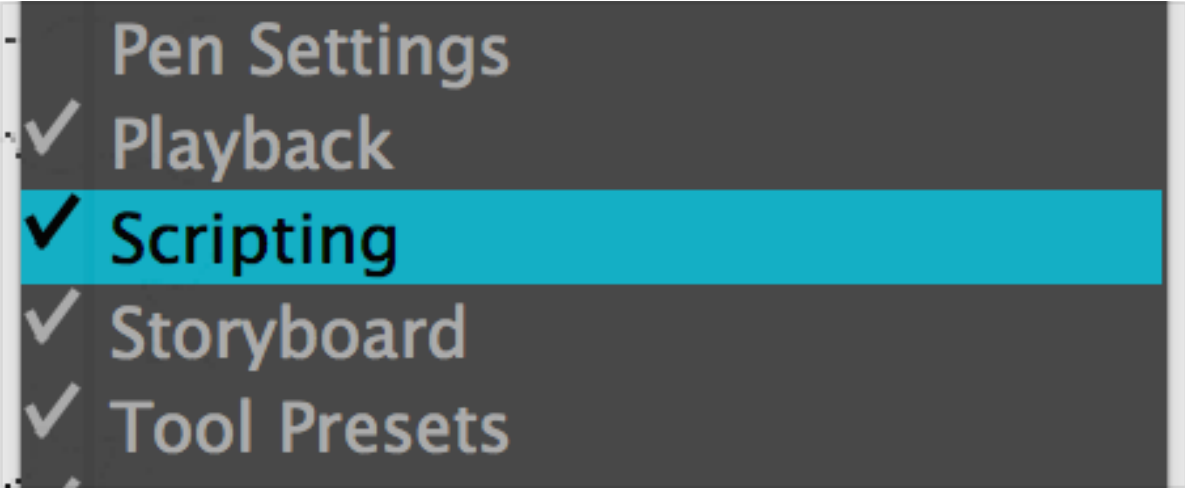


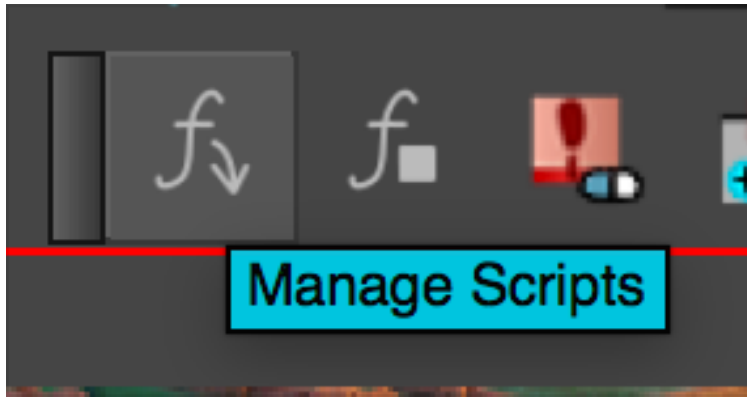
Using the import Script selection in the upper left corner, find the JS files on your

desktop and bring them into the Script Editor.

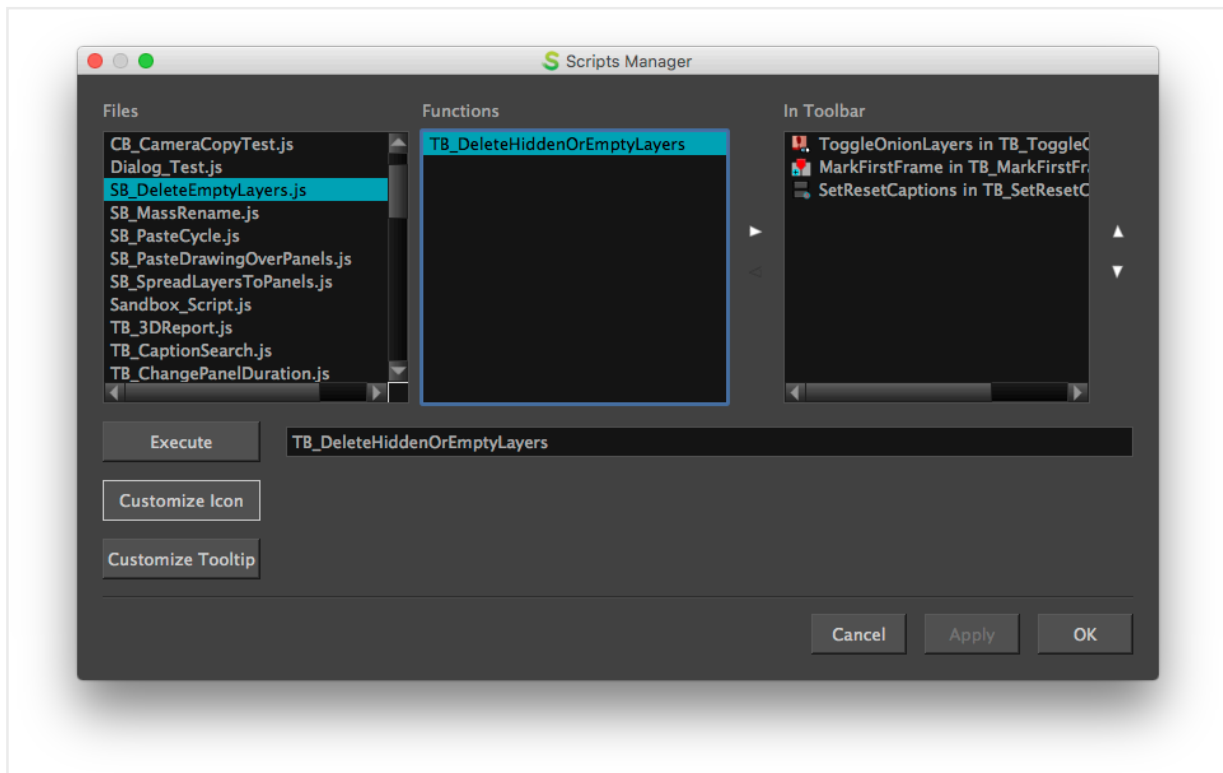


Once your scripts are imported, make sure Scripting is enabled in the toolbars by right clicking the toolbar and checking off "Scripting." From that point, you'll be able to access the Script Manager.





You now have access to the Script Manager. From here you can seek out the scripts you wish to add to your toolbar. You can also customize the scripts with the icons provided by clicking the Customize Icon button.



From here, the scripts will populate the Scripting tab. However, they can be customized into other tabs. Simply right click and scroll down to Customize. The available scripts will already be present in the listing.
